## The Role of a Volunteer Mentor

There is no need to travel.

A volunteer mentor simply opens a few links on their computer. The student and the volunteer see the same lesson materials on their screens.

Mentor and student converse through their computer microphone or by phone.

The mentoring sessions are very easy! Mentors are trained by participating in an on-line session that demonstrates how to access and use each of the lesson components.
